Samuel W. Bell (born July 7, 1989) is an American politician who serves in the <u>Rhode Island State Senate</u> representing the 5th district in <u>Providence</u>. A <u>Democrat</u>, he was first elected to the senate in the <u>2018 elections</u>, and assumed office in 2019. [1] Bell is a member of the Democratic Socialists of America. [2]

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Education

Bell attended Amherst College were he earned a Bachelor's degree in Astronomy and Geology. Bell also attended Brown University were he earned a Master's degree in Geosciences and a Ph.D. in Earth, Environmental, and Planetary Science. [3]

Career

A data scientist at Brown University prior to his election to the legislature, Bell was most noted for an investigation which revealed that the <u>National Rifle Association</u> was illegally funneling national money into Rhode Island state elections in

an attempt to prevent the state from passing <u>gun control</u> legislation. His investigation resulted in the NRA being forced to shut down its Rhode Island political action committee. [4]

Bell decided to become involved in politics as a result of the <u>Sandy Hook Elementary School shooting</u> in <u>Newtown</u>, <u>Connecticut</u> in 2012. Bell defeated incumbent senator <u>Paul Jabour</u> in the <u>Democratic primary</u> in <u>September 2018, and ran unopposed in the general election. He assumed office on January 1, 2019.</u>

Bell ran for re-election in <u>2020</u>, being challenged in the Democratic primary by majority leader of the Providence City Council Jo-Ann Ryan. [8] Bell defeated Ryan by 50 percentage points, and ran

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unopposed in the general election.[9]

When not in the senate Bell works as a geologist. [5]

Senator Bell proposed legislation that "would impose fines and double the taxes of those who refuse COVID-19 vaccine." [10]

Personal life

Bell is married to Samantha Weiser, a chairwoman of the Rhode Island Democratic Women's Caucus who also works for <u>Hasbro</u>. [3][11] Bell and his wife are both <u>Jewish</u> and <u>identify</u> as <u>bisexual</u>. [12] They live together in <u>Mount Pleasant</u>. [5] In October 2018, Bell publicly alleged that he and Weiser were personally targeted with <u>antisemitic</u> and <u>homophobic</u> posts from users of the <u>neo-Nazi</u> forum website Stormfront. [12]

Weiser gave birth to their son, Jacob Tsvi Weiser Bell, on December 10, 2021. Shortly after birth Jacob was diagnosed with infant respiratory distress syndrome. [13]
